
ROUNDHILL COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

LANDSCAPE

We have undertaken photomontages to demonstrate how the solar farm will look from specific viewpoints in the local area. The models show the existing view, Yr.1 visualisation following construction, and Yr.10 once mitigation planting has substantially grown. These montages help deomstrate any potential adverse impact the scheme might have on local receptors, and how we can mitigate the harm. The montage below shows the scheme from a PROW adjacent to Roundhill Wood at Yr.10.



Another example is shown below. This photomontage was taken opposite the northeast corner of the scheme on Earls Common Road at an existing double width farm gate entrance. This is a Yr 10 montage demonstrating how the new hedgerow planting will effectively screen the site. Not only will the new planting provide a natural screen to the solar farm, the hedgerows will increase the natural habitat assets for local wildlife.
